PRESCHOOL

The YMCA offers a wonderful place where your child can learn and grow in a safe and nurturing environment. The programs are operated on an experiential learning philosophy - children learn by doing. The theme-based curriculum includes skill building for kindergarten readiness through a literacy-based circle time, arts, dramatic play, math concepts, building blocks, games, and physical play. The children learn positive social skills through a program and staff that teaches and demonstrates the values of honesty, responsibility, caring and respect. Our preschool programs encourage family involvement through special events, newsletters, parent advisory committees and volunteers in the classrooms. The goal of the YMCA Preschool is to give children a balanced experience that develops social emotional and intellectual skills.

"LATE NIGHT CARE"

"Late Night" is a child care program for working parents until 11:30 P.M.. "Late Night" provides quality, safe and dependable care for late night activities including individual study time, arts and crafts, swimming, snacks and more. School age children can be transported from the Pomona Y afterschool program to 676 N Gibbs to participate in the extended care program.
